COVID-19 RESOURCE TRACKER FOR ZIMBABWE RESPONSE MECHANISM

The COVID-19 resource tracker is an initiative by ZIMCODD conducted as a parallel effort to Government's response to Covid-19. Like any other country in the world, Zimbabwe has been in the process of mobilising resources to adequately respond to the devastating effects of the novel corona virus. ZIMCODD notes with concern that the stewardship over resources mobilised is equally important as the resources themselves. ZIMCODD therefore has developed the tracker as a tool to improve transparency and accountability by the government on all the resources that have been and will be channelled to the Covid-19 fight.
