
OVERVIEW

Zimbabwe has been trying to mobilise resources to respond in the best way possible to the devastating social and economic efects of corona virus. The Zimbabwe COVID-19 resource tracker is a civil society initiative by ZIMCODD to keep track of all resources pledged, received and utilised by the government of Zimbabwe in the COVID-19 response. ZIMCODD notes with concern that accountability for these resources is equally imporant as the resources themselves. This tracker has been developed to strengthen transparency and accountability by the government on COVID-19 resources while empowering citizens with information to hold the government to account on allocation and utilisation of COVID-19 resources. The tracker is updated on a weekly basis to show pledges honoured, resources received and resources expended.



MAJOR CONCERNS

- The deplorable state of public service delivery in Zimbabwe is a cause for concern in the COVID-19 context. Unavailability of safe, clean and portable water and deplorable sanitation infrastructure is exposing citizens to more infectious diseases.
- Citizens are concerned about how the health sector continues to be underfunded in spite of the trickling in of resources both in cash and in-kind donations. The incapacity of health institutions to manage COVID-19 and shortage of PPEs remains worrying as it exposes citizens to the novel virus.
- The poor management and embezzlement of COVID-19 funds has aggravated poverty, inequalities and untold suffering for citizens whose livelihoods have been ravaged by COVID-19 and related lockdown measures.
- t• Citizens bemoan government profligacy, the lack of integrity, transparency and accountability in COVID-19 resource allocation and expenditure at both central and local government level which has been the breeding ground for corruption, resource leakages and abuse of COVID-19 earmarked resources.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNMENT

- To prioritise effective public service delivery as it plays a greater role in protecting citizens from the deadly coronavirus. This will ensure that citizens' right to quality healthcare, safe and portable water are guaranteed.
- To increase resources to fund the health sector so as to address the capacity, equipment and infrastructure gaps in the health sector. Personal protective equipment should be prioritised for frontline workers.
- Strengthen oversight and accountability institutions and anticorruption agencies to alleviate the abuse of COVID-19 earmarked resources.
- Government to publish all COVID-19 funds received to date including a clear breakdown of allocations, disbursements and
- outstanding pledges. All COVID-19 resources disbursed to provinces and districts should be properly accounted for.
 The government must disclose and publish all the beneficial owners of the companies that won COVID-19 related contracts



in order to track down on corruption.
