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


COVID-19 RESOURCE TRACKER

OVERVIEW

Zimbabwe has been trying to mobilise resources to respond in the best way possible to the devastating social and economic effects of corona virus. The Zimbabwe COVID-19 resource tracker is a civil society initiative by ZIMCODD to keep track of all resources pledged, received and utilised by the government of Zimbabwe in the COVID-19 response. ZIMCODD notes with concern that accountability for these resources is equally imporant as the resources themselves. This tracker has been developed to strengthen transparency and accountability by the government on COVID-19 resources while empowering citizens with information to hold the government to account on allocation and utilisation of COVID-19 resources. The tracker is updated on a weekly basis to show pledges honoured, resources received and resources expended.





Illustrated below are sources of the resources pledged, honoured and utilised, All other forms of contributions have been convered into monetary value. All currencies were convered to USD at Government of Zimbabwe interbank rate. Percentage (%) indicates resources utilized

MAJOR CONCERNS

• The deplorable state of public service delivery in Zimbabwe is a cause for concern in the COVID-19 context. The crippled public health sector, lack of availability of safe and clean water and deplorable sanitation infrastructure is exposing citizens to more infectious diseases.

• Citizens are concerned about the incapacity of health institutions to manage COVID-19, shortages of PPEs poorly located and under resourced quarantine centres which is further exposing citizens to contracting the novel virus.

• Citizens bemoan the lack of integrity, transparency and accountability in COVID-19 resource allocation and expenditure at both central and local government level which has been the breeding ground for corruption, resource leakages, abuses and mismanagement of COVID-19 earmarked resources.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNMENT

• To prioritise effective public service delivery as it plays a greater role in protecting citizens from the deadly coronavirus. This will ensure that citizens' right to quality healthcare, safe and portable water are guaranteed.

• Resuscitate and reform the health service delivery system to address the capacity, equipment and infrastructure gaps in the health sector.

• Government to publish all COVID-19 funds received to date including a clear breakdown of allocations, disbursements and outstanding pledges
