

# Journal of Social & Economic Justice (JSEJ) Call for Extended Abstracts

Zimbabwe Coalition on Debt and Development (ZIMCODD) is calling for abstracts for its Journal of Social and Economic Justice (JSEJ). JSEJ gives an opportunity to members of the Civil Society Organisations (CSOs), academia, and government officials to add extensively to the body of knowledge. JSEJ is premised on the need to influence the policy making machinery and takes pride in creating an opportunity for academia, activists, scholars and authors to submit their original and extended research. The published articles will be used to generate and further debate around social and economic justice policy-oriented discourse thereby increasing chances of having social and economic issues to be transferred from the attentive public to the sub-government. Thus, the JSEJ will publish periodically, cutting-edge research premised on key, pressing, recent and relevant people-oriented policy discourse embedded with social and economic justice.

Extended abstracts must focus on the following Public Finance Management thematic areas: Domestic Resource Mobilisation; Public Debt; Corruption Risk in Public Finance Management; Tax Administration; National and Local Authorities Budgeting Process; and Public Procurement.

The extended abstract should have a maximum of 2000 words clearly specifying theoretical and empirical gaps that the researcher is addressing. It must be a concise review, bringing to light a brief description of the methodology used, results obtained, the expected contribution to theory and practice and the conclusion resulting from the study. The extended abstract should make use of the Harvard referencing style.

#### Review

JSEJ uses double-blind peer review framework to assess all submissions.
